Create an even better worship experience-

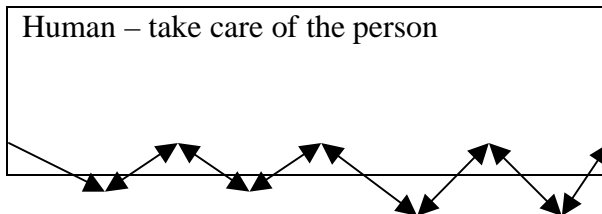
Leadership:
